

Hall of Fame Nomination Breeding Horse Category (sires or dams)

Criteria:

Nomination must be deceased

Inductee into the NSBA Hall of Fame must have been outstanding for a period of years as a sire or dam. The horse's show career will be taken into consideration. Stallions must have a remarkable record as a sire of NSBA horses with earnings, points and titles as well as broodmare sire statistics. Broodmares must have been prolific producers of NSBA horses in earnings, points and titles with more than one successful foal. Horses should be selected based on NSBA competition chronologically, honoring older horse first. Induction into the horse category must be deceased. The last recorded owner shall receive the award. * *Deadline for nominations is October 1st*
