Eligibility Requirements

1. Riders must be disabled veterans, active duty or retired.
2. Riders may be participants in a PATH Intl. Equine program or have a Department of Veteran Affairs disability rating.
3. The PATH Int'l. facility will be responsible for verifying the eligibility of riders participating in Equine Services for Heroes programs.
4. Disabled Veterans who do not participate in a therapeutic riding program, must submit the Department of Veteran Affairs letter recording the dates of service, the Service-connected Disability Rating, and the date it was awarded.
5. Please black out all other personal information included in the letter such as social security number and monthly monetary award.
6. Horses need not be registered or owned by the rider or facility.

The following classes are offered at the NSBA World Championship Show for Heroes on Horses:

- Heroes on Horses - Walk-Trot Western Pleasure - Independent Rider*
- Heroes on Horses - Walk-Trot Western Pleasure - Supported*

**There will be no fee for participation in these classes*

A rider may not show in any youth, amateur or open categories while showing in the Equestrians with Disabilities classes. A rider may show in only one of the Equestrians with Disabilities/Heroes on Horses categories, Independent or Supported. If a rider's condition deteriorates so that the rider can no longer ride as an independent rider, but now needs support, this must be documented by the physician and, if participating in a therapeutic riding program, the certified PATH instructor.
